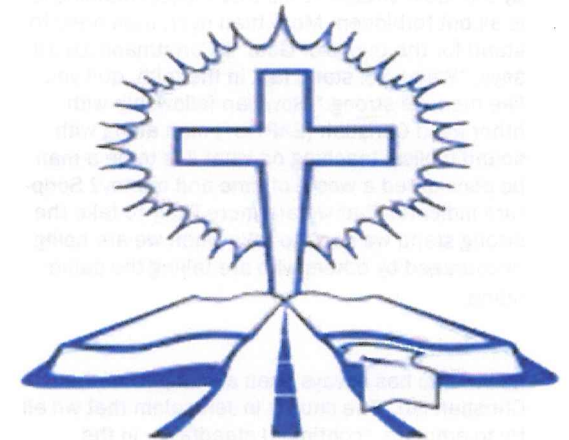

Driving Directions

From Seattle: (1^{1/2}hrs)

I-5 South to exit #111 (Marvin RD - Yelm), turn left and follow Highway 510 12 miles to Yelm

From Portland: (2^{1/2}hrs)

I-5 North to exit #88A to Tenino. At Tenino, join Highway 507 North and follow it through Rainier and into Yelm. Turn right onto Yelm Ave.

In Yelm:

Follow Yelm Ave to the east end of town and turn right onto Bald Hills Road. Proceed 9 miles and turn left onto Peissner RD (after the fire station). Go 1.7 miles and turn right under the Cascades gateway.
