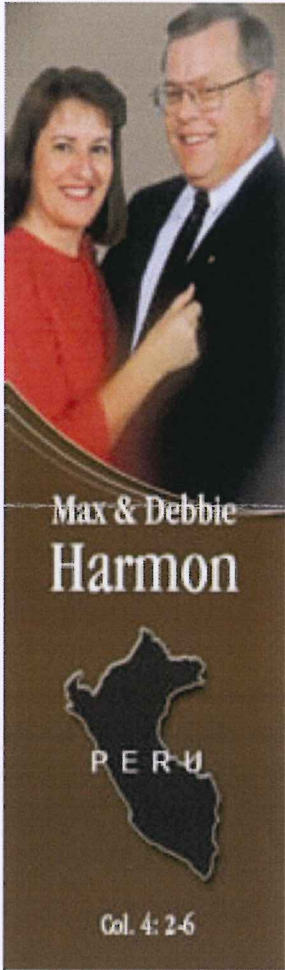

\$230,000 donated & loaned & re-loaned since 2001

\$300,000 repaid by 75 Peruvian Baptist churches (interest free)

\$750,000 processed since the inception of the Peruvian based fund.

\$350,000 out in current loans

55 churches have totally repaid their loans.

All but two churches faithfully repay each month.
