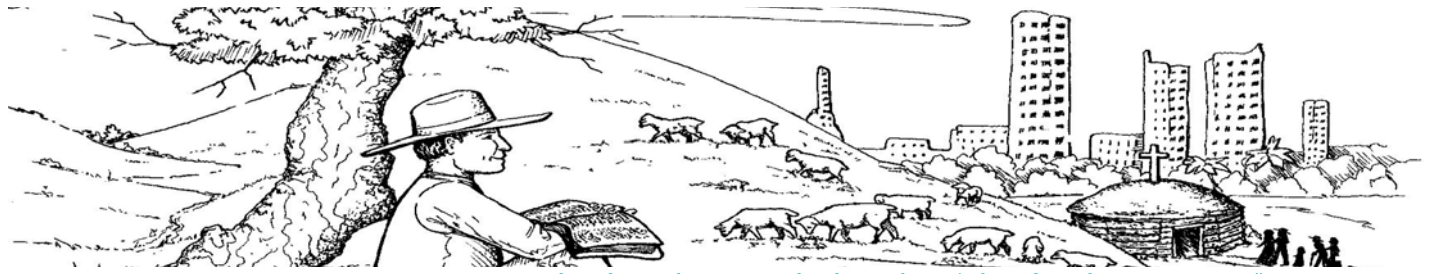

Business meeting: Please look hard at the financial figures under **"New Support Needed"**! The truth is, in greater detail, that we have raised \$770 (\$435 new support & \$335 of increased support).

*However, we have lost \$290 (\$190 of dropped support – due to churches "re-organizing" their missions programs & \$100 in decreased support – due to the hard economic times.)
