Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

The "fields" are ready to be harvested, but labors are few

What a wild 3 months this has been!! Since March, the ministry has kept us very busy. As I reported in a previous letter, we started youth meetings for youth only, on Friday nights in April. In Brazil, everybody goes to all services including the Saturday Night scheduled youth meetings, and the teens wanted something just for them with no adults or children. So now Friday nights is their night. Our first night we had 10 teens, 6 were first time visitors. We have had 13-20 kids with visitors each night since. We have not had any kids saved yet, but we have had an opportunity to get into many of the homes of the visiting teens. As we made visits, it broke my heart to see so many kids who are without direction and hope. We saw that there were 4-5 homes behind the main homes on the street where we had to follow a path to get to them. People who know nothing of God and His love for them were everywhere. There is so much to do, the need is so great, and there is so little time to do it. It is so heartbreaking. Please pray that the Lord will send forth more labors into this field.

A new chapter in our lives

Bethany and I arrived in the United States June 16 so that she can start the next chapter in her life. We arrived just in time for the birth of my second grandbaby, Liberty Anne Summerfield born June 17 at 8:30 AM, 5 days early. God is so good to allow us to be here for her arrival. It has been a blessing to get to know her and Lincoln (20 months), who only knew us through the web cam. Now he knows that Grandma Mimi and Aunt Bessy are real people and not just a computer image.

Prayer requests

- Since there are no lessons available in Portuguese it has been a challenge for me to write lessons and then translate them for the teens, my Sunday School class, and ladies meetings. At times I feel that I only have time to write lessons. Please pray that I will have wisdom on how to prepare these lessons, and that I can keep them simple so the people can understand.

-The Pastor and his wife, with whom I have been working, have become so discouraged because of the lack of interest for the work of the Lord despite their faithfulness. Please pray for Pastor Massias and Welita that they will not give up and that this little church will soon have a victory and see great things done for the cause of Christ.

-Bethany (18) as she starts this new phase in her life that she will continue to grow spiritually and allow God to be a part of her decisions, and that she will be open to His direction in her life.

-Rachel (22) as she faces some life struggles that through these struggles she will allow God to show her that these trials can bring her closer to Him and to depend on Him for everything.

-Sarah and Greg, (my oldest daughter and son-in-law) as they adjust to having another baby, that they will continue to be godly parents, and that God will give them wisdom as they lead the youth in their youth department.
