Hilda lives in Chimaltenango about half a mile from our church. Hilda's brother goes to a Baptist church about three hours away. Hilda's brother has been trying to get her to come to our church for some time. Not knowing anyone in our church, she was hesitant to come. One of the ladies in our church just walked by, gave her a tract, and invited her not knowing who she was. Hilda saw on the tract that it was the same church her brother had been trying to get her to visit. She came the next Sunday. I visited her the following week and she got saved. When she came to church the next Sunday, she followed the Lord in baptism. She has been faithful ever since, even going soul winning with us. **What a difference a tract can make!**

Praise the Lord! Not only have we been able to purchase our property, but we have also started remodeling it to better fit our needs. Lord willing, within the next two years, we will finish the remodeling project and the auditorium on the second floor. Many of you have given to this project, and we are very grateful for your sacrifice.

Please pray for Noe Ajuquejay, a 16-year-old in our church. He was working in the field, and his leg got caught in some type of feed grinder. It got cut off just below the knee. This happened for a reason, so please pray that God's will would be accomplished in this.

There is so much that needs to be done here. At the first of the year, we could start a Christian school, Bible college, and two new churches if we just had the workers. I don't believe that the Lord has forgotten to call laborers to His harvest; I believe that the laborers have not gone. Please pray that they would go. There are 14 million people just in Guatemala that are waiting for them.
